County School News from Mrs. Martha Mulkey's Office

Improvement of School Buildings
Several school districts have reported as to improvements which are being made at this time. The Pleasant Hill district is receiving a new outer coat of paint; the Sitkum school

building is to be painted; the Bald Hill building is being improved and electric lights are being installed; the Parkersburg school is carrying on some needed repair and is also painting the building. Rumors have come to us indirectly from Bridge, Etalka and some other districts which would indicate that throughout the county buildings were being gotten into shape for school. Several school districts have recently had blackboards refinished and a large number of districts have had books repaired through the office of the county school superintendent. The city schools are making considerable improvements. We understand that Bandon is to rebuild; Marshfield is having painting and repairing done; the teacherage in the Myrtle Point district is being refinished; the Coquille gym is in process of construction; and Powers is thoroughly renovating the grade building, refinishing blackboards and putting a new roof on the gym.

The following schools have reported as having recently bought new sets of Compton's Pictured Encyclopedia which is one of the two approved for use in Oregon: Remote, Broadbent, Arago, Twin Oaks, Catching Inlet, Millington, Randolph, Haynes Inlet, McKinley, Sumner, Etalka, Sitkum, Coaledo, Eastside.

Amendment For School Funds
The amendment to the Oregon constitution, which would have increased the state school fund to \$10 per child, will not appear on the ballot. Indebtedness Watched
Twenty-two school districts carry an indebtedness of \$173,533.03 of the total school district warrant debt of \$177,539.68. This information was presented to the district boundary board by W. H. Wann at the completion of his audit for school districts. The district boundary board is urging districts in as far as possible to get on to a cash basis.

The writer is calling attention to the fact that most of the school districts were on a cash basis at the time of going into the depression. The problem of running schools would have been even more acute if these districts had been in debt at that time.
