News From County School Supt. Office

Clerks Receive Elementary Fund
The school clerks of all the school districts have recently received money from the elementary school fund. The total of this is \$21,639.56. This fund, like the state school fund and the county school fund is apportioned through the office of the county school superintendent.

The elementary fund is apportioned as follows: Each spring the county superintendent is required to divide the total amount at that time on hand according to the number of elementary teachers employed in the first eight grades but that in determining number of teachers employed the number shall not exceed one teacher for every 27 pupils in average daily attendance or fraction thereof, for the current year.

The money which has just been sent out is a duplicate of that sent out in the spring. Due to the fact that the school year has not closed in the spring when apportionment is made, records are incomplete and it is therefore sometimes necessary to make an adjustment in the fund during the ensuing spring.

An attempt is being made to get the apportionment law changed so that this later adjustment will not be necessary.

Remote Club Gives Books
The Community Club at Remote voted to give \$20 toward the school library. The teacher, Curtis Beckham, has been instructed to make the selection of books and magazines.
