

Youth Council Activities In Coquille

The two playgrounds operated by the Youth Council saw a gradual growth of attendance during the initial week of operations. Many boys and girls in the community took advantage of the games. Free play was the order all week. This week, the Myrtle Grove playground is having the first tournaments. Today (Thursday) the first

tournament will be played off in croquet. There will be a bracket of eight or sixteen in each of the two divisions. The first division will take in players of fourteen years of age and below. The second division will include players fifteen years of age and on up.

Friday afternoon will be a ping pong tournament. The divisions will be the same as for croquet. Prizes will be awarded the winners. Whether you consider you are a good player or not, you are very welcome to enter the tournament. Entries are made at 1 p. m. the day of the tournament or any time during the morning.
