NOTES

There will be no "reunion" or "party" at the newspaper office during the final count—which will begin as soon after 9 o'clock Saturday night as all candidates (who will be in the office by that time) can be worked on. Only the judges, the publisher and the campaign manager will be allowed in the office during the count. This will enable the judges to finish the count in a shorter time.

Any candidate who does not turn in at least two more subscriptions by 9 o'clock Saturday night will NOT get a prize or a commission. This is a rule of the campaign and will be strictly enforced. The best candidates will have several times two but each candidate MUST turn in at least two Saturday to win a prize or a commission. This is final and fair warning.

NOTES

IN ORDER TO AVOID ALL POSSIBILITY OF ERROR IN THE VOTE COUNT EACH CANDIDATE (ACCOMPANIED BY PARENT OR GUARDIAN) IS URGED TO COME TO THE SENTINEL OFFICE PREPARED TO CHECK UP THE AMOUNT OF CASH HE OR SHE HAS TURNED IN, AND THE NUMBER OF VOTES AND POINTS HE OR SHE HAS UP TO AND INCLUDING THEIR WEDNESDAY'S REPORT, WITH THE CAMPAIGN MANAGER'S RECORD. PLEASE COME IN FRIDAY AFTERNOON OR EVENING FOR THIS PURPOSE, IF YOU POSSIBLY CAN, OTHERWISE ANYTIME SATURDAY WILL BE ALL RIGHT. AT THE SAME TIME THE CANDIDATES WILL BE GIVEN THE NECESSARY SLIP TO PUT IN THE BALLOT BOX WITH THEIR FINAL REMITTANCE.

CANDIDATES WHO DO NOT COME IN TO CHECK WILL BE CONSIDERED AS HAVING GIVEN NOTICE TO THE JUDGES THEY ACCEPT THE CAMPAIGN MANAGER'S COUNT AS ABSOLUTELY CORRECT IN EVERY DETAIL.

NOTES

The friends who paid their subscriptions to you did it to help you and because they thought you would work to help yourself. If you do not do your best the last hours of the campaign you are not doing right by your friends who have already supported you.

A race is never won or lost until the final lap is run. At this stage of the campaign some candidates get over confident and others suffer from under-confidence. Either of these symptoms is dangerous, as no candidate has anything "cinched" at this time—neither is there any candidate who cannot win one of the most valuable prizes if he or she only goes after it in earnest between now and 9 o'clock Saturday night.

Ask the Campaign Manager Saturday what time you are to call for your prize. We ask that the candidates winning bicycles be ready to make a quick decision as to which prize bicycle he or she wishes, so it will not hold us up in getting the prizes to the other candidates as quickly as possible. The candidates not winning bicycles will have their commission checks mailed to them by Tuesday.

DETAILS OF THE FINAL COUNT

In order to maintain the utmost secrecy as to the number of subscriptions and votes secured by each candidate during the last three days of the campaign the race will be brought to a close under a sealed ballot box system. No subscriptions or money will be accepted from candidates by the campaign department during the last three days of the campaign; instead the candidates will deposit their final collections and subscriptions in the sealed ballot box located in the window of the Sentinel office. The campaign manager will collect from subscribers who come to the office to pay and will put in the ballot box for whatever candidate it is credited to. If any candidate cannot come to the office they may mail their report to the campaign manager and he will see it gets in the sealed box. Candidates will have access to this sealed ballot box any time.

The candidates will simply place their money and subscriptions in a sealed envelope and deposit it in the sealed ballot box. This means that no one but the candidates will know what they do these last three days until the campaign has been officially declared ended and the ballot box is opened by the judges for the final count. This assures fairness to the nth degree. The winners will be determined by the judges merely adding the votes and points for the subscriptions contained in the sealed ballot box, to each candidate's total up to last Wednesday night as shown by their individual signed statements. Every effort will be made to finish the final count Saturday night, so the prizes may be given to the candidates that night or Sunday. A bulletin will be placed in the window of The Sentinel office Sunday morning showing the final standing of the candidates.

ALL CANDIDATES IN THE OFFICE BY 9 O'CLOCK SATURDAY NIGHT, HOWEVER, WILL BE GIVEN AN OPPORTUNITY TO CHECK WITH THE CAMPAIGN MANAGER, AND TO DEPOSIT THEIR FINAL COLLECTIONS IN THE SEALED BALLOT BOX.

Just as you are in the office by 9 o'clock Saturday night, you will be waited on and your subscriptions will be counted by the judges. You cannot mail or deliver any after 9 o'clock Saturday night. Be sure you get all your subscriptions and money to our office in time.

When you come in Saturday with your final report, please return to the Campaign Manager all receipt books and mailing lists which have been furnished you. This is important to us, so please comply with this request.

Any candidate whose name appears on the list printed today will be certain of winning a prize or a commission if he or she gets at least two more subscriptions turned in by 9 o'clock Saturday night.

Wednesday was the biggest report day to date and Saturday will be even bigger.

There is nothing more we can say—the campaign ends at 9 o'clock Saturday night. If the short time left—and the value of the prizes—does not make you do your best in these last few days, surely nothing we could say or do would urge you on to win the most valuable prize of a beautiful and durable bicycle.
