Chevrolet Reports Brisk Interest in 1941 Cabriolet

Although it is still winter by the calendar, and occasionally by the weather, the thoughts of many motorists are already turning definitely to a "car for spring" in the opinion of Cliff Gulseth.

The Chevrolet man bases his opinion on the growing number of inquiries for information on the 1941 Chevrolet cabriolet model. The cabriolet in this year's version, he states, is a marked improvement over the highly successful 1940 model of its type. It is built on the special deluxe chassis only.

"Improvements in this 'open or closed' model are numerous, the executive explained, 'and are not confined to externals, extensive as such refinements are. The improvements extend to fundamentals of body construction and bring to the industry for the first time, a cabriolet which for freedom from shake and body movement equals the best that the closed car body can offer."

Though weight is not greatly altered, the Chevrolet man pointed out that the overall torsional stiffness between axle centers of the new V-K frame is nearly three times that of 1940, while beam stiffness is increased 21 percent.

The well-known vacuum-operated top, which made such a hit with owners last year, has been improved noticeably, he observed. Improved "geometry" of the top-operating linkage has made for easier working of the power unit.

"Chevrolet designers really concentrated on this swanky model," the Chevrolet man stated. "Last year's big success was the cue to them to produce a cabriolet with even more style appeal and solid value. From folding top to road surface, they have developed what the young-minded motorists of all ages will be calling this spring 'a honey'—a car with top-down smartness plus top-up snugness worthy of a regular steel-bodied coupe."

"The Horn" is an exciting hunt ballad in which the orchestra's four French horns play an important role.
