### Union Dedicates Flag Pole Saturday

There was a fine crowd on the platform in front of the Plywood plant at 10 o'clock last Saturday morn when the flagpole sponsored by the Plywood Local No. 2691, was dedicated and the new flag presented by the local was raised.

As far as is known this is the first time that a union organization on the coast has provided a pole and flag to be displayed over the employer's plant.

The union has designated one of its members to raise the flag each morning and another to lower it in the evening and lay it away in a box especially made to receive it.

R. A. Jeub, of the Smith Wood-Products company, who is also chairman of the Americanization committee of the local Legion post, presided at the ceremony.

Two Scouts, Tony Newton and Bob Holbrook, raised the flag while the C. H. S. band, directed by Thos. Cauthers, played "The Star Spangled Banner."

Allan A. Hall, Marshfield attorney, made a very fine eight to ten minute

address, declaring that the American laboring man enjoys more privileges and more of the comforts of life than do those of any other country on earth, but he cautioned that those privileges entailed the utmost in responsibilities in these perilous days when the United States is hastening defense measures all over the nation, and the union man owed it as much to his government as did the business or professional man, or industrialist, to see that nothing interferes with the rapid and smooth flow of all defense preparation.

The committee of the union which made the arrangements for the ceremony, and had the dock kept clear of cars, and all articles removed that morning from the space occupied by the spectators, consisted of S. On Tuesday this week they met at the Washington school, elected Mary Anne Walker as scribe, and planned a camping trip at Camp Cleawox for this summer.

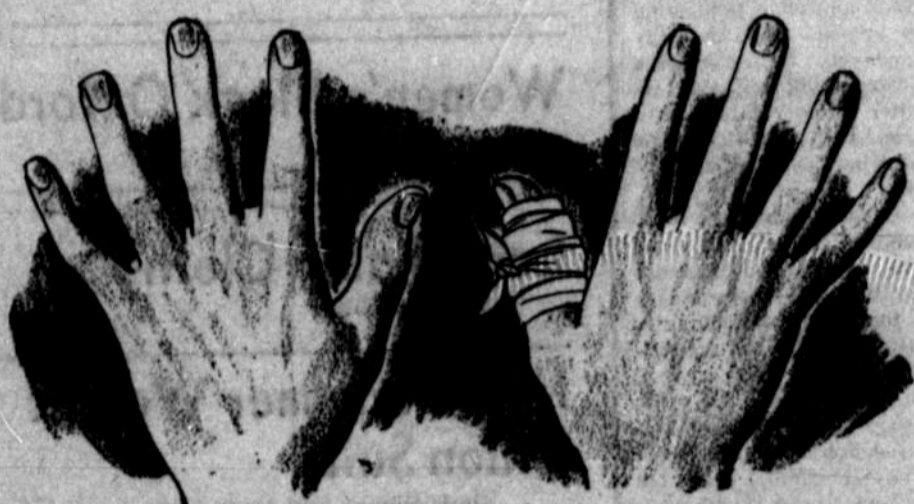

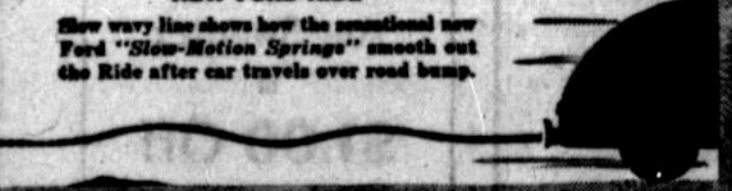

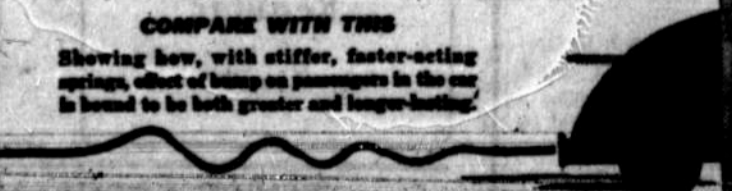
#### NEW FORD RIDE
