Cash income of the American public in July was \$1.01 for every \$1 a year earlier. This gain of one cent on the dollar resulted from the following changes per dollar: wages off 2 cents, salaries off one cent on the \$1.00; other income upseven cents on the dollar and investment income at \$1.08 was upsight cents.

Rents in July were unchanged compared with a year ago. Clothing was up four cents. Food was down one cent. Miscellaneous items were no three cents.
