

Candle Wax Will Prevent Holes In Toes and Heels

Waxing heels and toes of stockings with a bit of candle wax is routine here economy long ago in wooden-shoe lands of Europe, and it is a practical way to meet stocking problems today. Textile specialists of the U. S. Department of Agriculture who have put to laboratory tests this old-fashioned custom report that rubbing wax on stockings makes them wear four times as long before holes appear in heels or toes, says Mrs. Dorothy B. Dunn, Coos County Home Demonstration Agent.

Tests showed the simplest and most effective method is merely rubbing a piece of candle wax or paraffin on heels and toes before each wearing. Even if the waxing is not repeated until after several launderings, enough wax remains to make stockings last more durable. The experiments were made on cotton stockings, but the toe and heel waxing method adds to the durability of wool or rayon hose in the same way. If only a thin film of wax is applied, it will not interfere with the proper laundering of the stockings nor change their appearance.
