I wish to state that I was discharged from my position of Bookkeeper and Deputy County Clerk of Coos county by L. W. Oddy, County Clerk, said discharge becoming effective on the 18th or 20th of May, 1945.

To Slaughter Farmers Must Get Permit At Once

Farmers who slaughter meat for sale, transfer or gift, or expect to, are urged to file an application for a permit at once with the local Board if they have not already done so.

"Applications for permits for Class III slaughterers will not be taken after the July 1 deadline." Farm slaughterers who did not apply May 13 may not sell nor transfer meat until they get their applications in, and farmers should not put off meeting this requirement any longer and risk losing the chance to get a license or permit.

Class III slaughterers include persons who "live on and operate a farm and slaughter, or had slaughtered for them livestock from which they sold or transferred during 1944 or during a 12-month period from January 1, 1944, to March 31, 1945, not more than 6,000 pounds of meat."

Farmers who delivered no meat or less than 400 pounds in 1944 may obtain a permit to deliver up to 400 pounds.

No limitations are placed on slaughter for home consumption.
