

### Former Coquille Girl Taken By Death

Friends and acquaintances of Jennie Amend Anderson are saddened to learn of her sudden death at McAuley Hospital, Coos Bay, on Sunday, June 10, after a brief illness.

She was born Jennie Margaret Amend on February 27, 1923, at Nooksack, Wash., having been 22 years of age her last birthday.

She moved to Oregon with her parents when only a small child and grew to womanhood on their farm on the Fairview road. She attended Cunningham grade school and graduated in the spring of 1937. She later attended North Bend high school, having moved in the fall with her parents to Empire.

One year later she was married to Cecil M. Anderson, whom she leaves to mourn her loss; also two sons, Glenn, five years, and infant son, Marion LeRoy, born June 7.

She is also survived by her mother, Georgia A. Amend, of Empire; her father, Rufus M. Amend, of Portland, and four sisters: Mrs. Grace Smith, Myrtle Point; Mrs. Ruth Rivers, Fairview route, Coquille; Mrs. Hazel Vincent, Coquille, and Mrs. Elsie Dawson, Astoria; grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. A. S. Amend, Vista, Calif., and Mrs. Ellen Sturgeon, Everson, Wash.; a great aunt, several uncles, aunts, cousins and nephews.
