

Adolph Haberly Services Held

Funeral services for Rev. Adolph Haberly, who died suddenly Friday, Feb. 15, 1946, at his home near Oak Grove, Oregon, were held Tuesday, Feb. 19 at 1:00 p. m. at the Moreland Presbyterian church, S. E. 18th Ave. and Hybee Boulevard, Portland, Oregon. Vault entombment was at Riverview Abbey Mausoleum.

Dr. John M. Paxton and Dr. W. L. Killian officiated at the services. McGinnis and Wilhelm were in charge of funeral arrangements.

Coronary thrombosis was designated as the cause of the death of the retired Presbyterian minister, who was born in Switzerland November 2, 1867.

Rev. Mr. Haberly came to the United States at the age of six months. In 1892 he married Louisa Werren, and five years later he was graduated from the San Anselmo Theological seminary in San Francisco, Calif.

He held pastorates in Medford, Bandon, Myrtle Point, Coquille, as well as in a number of California and Kansas towns. Mr. Haberly retired in 1932 while pastor of the Blue Rapids, Kansas, Presbyterian church and returned to Bandon, Oregon, to make his home, where he was until the Bandon fire in 1936, after which he moved to Oak Grove where he lived until his death.

Surviving are his widow, Louisa Haberly; three daughters, Mrs. O. H. Aasen and Mrs. S. C. McAllister, both of Arago, Oregon, and Mrs. T. G. Little of Oak Grove, Oregon; six sons, John of Aloha, Oregon; L. L. Com, Adolph Haberly of the U. S. navy; Edward of New York; Theodore of Vernona; Robert of Richard, and Alfred of John Day. One son, Arnold, passed away at Albany in 1919. Also surviving are two brothers, Arnold of Smith Center, Kansas, and Albert of Salisbury Mo.; a sister, Mrs. Mary Eppensteiner of California; 14 grandchildren and three great grandchildren, and a host of friends in Oregon, California and Kansas.

Services Held For Mrs. Cotton
