NOTICE OF EXPIRATION OF THE ONE YEAR PERIOD OF TAX REDEMPTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by me, the undersigned, Sheriff and Tax Collector of Coos County, Oregon, pursuant to Section 110-916, O. C. L. A. that the one year period allowed by law for the redemption of property which was included in that certain tax foreclosure proceedings begun November 27, 1945, and in which judgment and decree was taken March 26, 1946, covering delinquent taxes for the year 1941 and prior years, expires March 27, 1947, and that all property ordered sold under and pursuant to the aforesaid judgment and decree foreclosing said tax liens of Coos County, Oregon, will be deemed by me, the undersigned, to Coos County, Oregon, a body politic and corporate of the State of Oregon, immediately upon the expiration of said period or redemption; and

That every right, title or interest of any persons, firm or corporation in and to such properties to be deemed will be forever forfeited to Coos County unless redemption is made on or prior to the 27th day of March, 1947, it being the last day allowed by law for the redemption of properties included within said tax foreclosure judgment and decree. Veterans To Receive Tax Benefits

With Saturday, March 15, the deadline for filing federal income tax returns, Director George E. Sandy of the Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs, today reminded World War II veterans of special provisions of the revenue act of 1945 which may save them considerable inconvenience and money. This act:

1. Excludes for taxation purposes all active-service pay received by enlisted men, including non-commissioned warrant officers.
 2. Also excludes benefits and subsistence allowances under the GI bill and Public Law 16, mustering-out pay, travel allowances and terminal leave pay bonds, pensions, disability compensation, servicemen's readjustment allowances and GI insurance refunds.
 3. Grants commissioned officers in the armed forces an exemption up to \$1500 on their service pay which, combined with the basic \$500 exemption on other gross income, totals \$2000.
- Sandy pointed out that these provisions apply only for income received during the war years, beginning with the calendar year 1941 and continuing until the official termination of the war.
- Income received from outside the service amounting to \$500 or more, he said, must be reported. Incomes amounting to less than \$500 on which there was withholding also should be reported. Sandy advised, in order to receive the refund. Veterans were advised to consult the internal revenue collector's office to learn of other provisions.
