Coquille Studio — A Home Town Business

"I'm looking for just the right man to buy my studio," said Frank Colvard, and Ed Throckmorton turned out to be the "right man." That was six years ago when he took over the Coquille studio.

During these years he and Mrs. Throckmorton have built Coquille's only exclusive camera store and studio into a thriving portrait, film and camera business. Recently the shop has had an attractive face lifting with the addition of some gold paint and green tile.

Just now special effort is being made to popularize the new Polaroid Land camera which takes and develops a picture in a minute. It is on display and being demonstrated.

Also a specialty with the shop is wedding photography. Invitations are sent out to the brides-to-be which "cordially invite you to call the Coquille Studio for your wedding pictures." Throckmorton covers out-of-town weddings, charging no extra fee for transportation or mileage. Prices fall into three categories, the \$30, \$40 and \$50 wedding. Each one yields a different size wedding book furnished by the studio at no extra cost, with cellophane pages for the pictures. All extra pictures cost the same as pictures taken in the studio.

Annuals are gotten out each spring, with exclusive pictures by the studio, for Coquille high school as well as many in surrounding districts. Throckmorton takes his equipment to the schools for this work.

Throckmorton does all his own photography and developing. His darkroom is located in the basement of the bank building and his assistants there are Charles Choate and LeVane Ramey. Mrs. Throckmorton's job includes taking care of the office and the bookkeeping, and applying the oil color to portraits. She also "likes to select the frames to fit the portraits."

She is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Fred McClellan of Coquille and the mother of two girls, Susan, 10, and Sally, 2. The Throckmorton's met and married in Missoula, Mont., while she was doing government work there and he was attending Washington State college at Pullman, Wash. He also did government photography work in Missoula, spent some time in the employ of the Apple Land Photo News in Yakima, Wash., and did similar work at Seattle, his home.

Special notice for his ability in photography showed up in the form of a blue ribbon at the Northwest photographic convention in Seattle this spring.

Anxious to help others learn his business, Throckmorton has volunteered his knowledge of the art in organizing a photography club in Coquille.

"We make a portrait of anything that moves might be a good slogan for our business," concluded Mrs. Throckmorton.
