Church Pontiac — Home - Owned Business

"The first time I drove a Pontiac, I thought it was the best car in the world, and I still think so," says Clovis Church, manager and owner of Church Pontiac, the local automotive business which has the dealership for Pontiac cars.

At that time Clovis Church was operating the service station where the G. I. Mobil Service station is now located. A friend from Portland drove in with a new Pontiac, and persuaded Clovis to take the car for a trial run. "Though it was the first time I had seen a Pontiac," Clovis says, "I fell for the car immediately, and that is the reason I set out to obtain the Pontiac dealership. And I still maintain that you can't beat a Pontiac."

Clovis has lived in Coos county since he was six years old. He came here with his parents from Clovis, New Mexico, where he was born. In fact, he was named for the town of his birth. After leaving school he worked for twelve or fourteen years for Farr and Elwood in Coquille and later operated a grocery store at Bandon for four years.

His first venture in the automotive line was the operation of the Mobil service station, which he sold in 1941, and moved across the street to the location of the old Shell Service station; where "Church Pontiac" had its beginnings.

Church Pontiac moved to its present location in 1945, and in 1947, a complete re-modelling job was started. Now the business is housed in a modern building which features an up-to-date show room, adequate offices, and well-equipped shop.

In addition to the dealership for Pontiac cars, Church maintains a repair shop which provides employment for five mechanics, Keith Mintonye, Elmer Goodpaster, Harold Sinclair, Al Dunn and Bill Pullen. Clovis, himself, handles the sales end of the business and in charge of the office is Mrs. Donna Mae Carmichael.

Business is good, Clovis states. The only trouble is that since the war, he has not been able to get enough cars to fill the orders on hand. Some orders on file are a year old, Mr. Church says.
