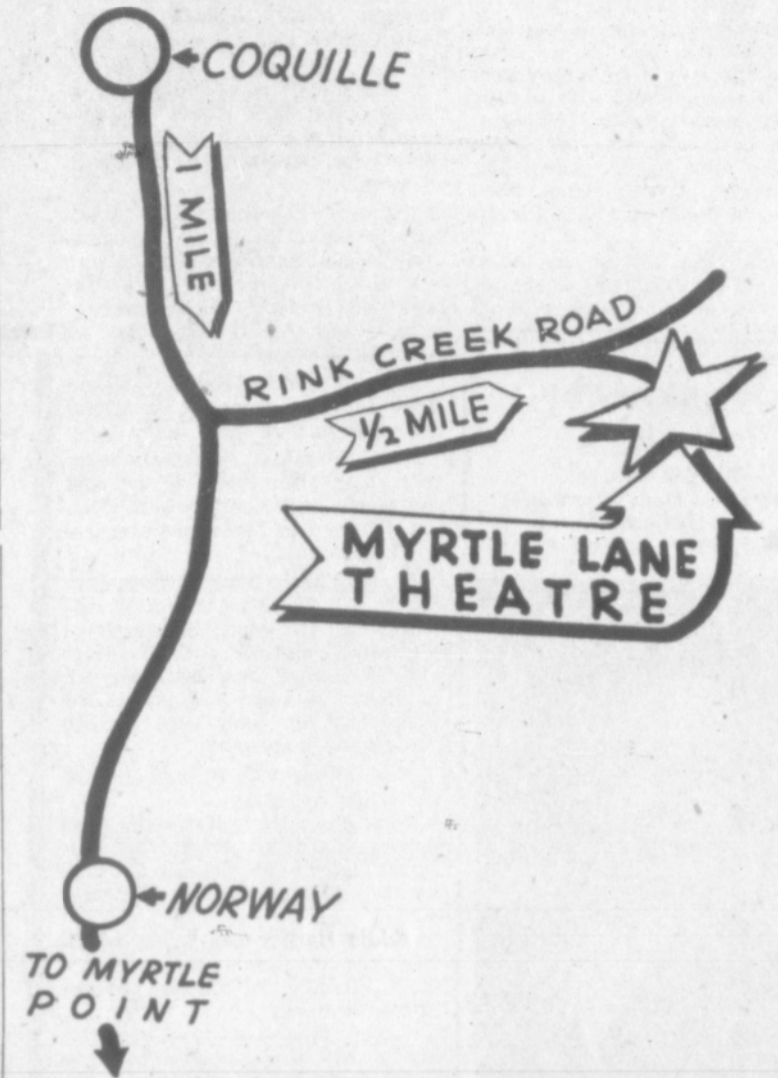

Here's How You Get To Myrtle Lane Drive-In Theatre



Come As You Are Is Convenient For Drive-In People

You don't have to dress up to go to a drive-in theatre. Baby sitters are out. The old, invalid or hard of hearing persons can be accommodated as well as young and healthy.

Drive-in theatres, such as the Myrtle Lane theater opening in Coquille offer a new field of entertainment.

Numerous features are available to drive-in patrons not possible in the regular theatres.

First, parking is no problem. You just drive your car to the theatre, buy your ticket, drive in and park and watch the show. If you get tired sitting in the car, there is a convenient snack bar available offering hotdogs, coffee, soft drinks and popcorn. Rest room facilities are also available.

Parents who have difficulty taking the little tots to theatres may care for them in their cars, or may put them to sleep in the rear seats. Crying children may bother their parents, but they won't bother the people in other cars.

It won't be necessary to go home just because it's baby's feeding time. Bottle warming service is offered patrons with babies at the Myrtle Lane theatre.

Sick or invalid persons who might have difficulty getting into a conventional theatre, may enjoy the motion pictures from their car. Hard of hearing persons may adjust the speakers for their individual cars to meet their own need. The speakers provide plenty of volume. They may also be turned very low for persons with sensitive ears.

"Come as you are" is the by-word for drive-in patrons.
