ANNUAL FORESTRY MEETING

Oregon's State board of forestry at its meeting held at the capitol last week proposed a memorial forest in honor of the late Nels Rogers, state forester. The details of the proposal will be worked out and presented to the board at the next meeting.

The board increased the rehabilitation budget for the 1950-51 fiscal year by \$168,000, bringing it up to \$473,000. Reports were made by State Forester George Spaur on the current fire season and on the spruce budworm spraying project which is the largest ever made in the history of forest production.

Expediting slash burning and the necessity of cutting snags during logging operations as a means of reducing fires throughout the state was urged by the board.

JOBLESS AID RECORD
