Parents Can Straighten Out Mess In Country, Speaker Tells Women

"It is possible that unless we, as parents, try to straighten out the mess our country is in today, our youth will follow in the same footsteps as did the youth of Germany under Hitler," Mrs. Henry Godshall, Vassar graduate and member of the Milner-Crest Parent-Teacher association, Coos Bay, told members of the Coquille Woman's club, Tuesday.

"The youth of today has to be taught to live American," she continued. "It is a known fact that while the German boys and girls followed under the rule of Hitler, they still came from good German families. Due to the election of such a poor man as the late Nazi leader, they had no other means of guidance and as the country was in a mess, the fault of the parents before them, their road of destiny was patterned by adult German men and women. Just this could happen if our leaders in Washington today are not selected according to their honest and right intentions for the good of all mankind," the speaker said.

She emphasizes the idea that it is not the fact that a presidential candidate is a Republic or a Democrat that counts, but that what he stands for, now and after he is elected. Regardless of how far away or how small a town is, from the Capitol Hill, every move made by all citizens counts. "Washington, D. C.," she said, "is in the palm of our hands, and what we do about it, will mold the destiny for our children!"

Using Burke's famous quotation, "Education is the cheapest defense a country can have," she continued along these lines in citing the drastic need for more teachers throughout the country today and explained in detail, the great need of keeping abreast of the growth in our schools through encouraging more young people to take up education as a career. She told members that 450,000 teachers and 750,000 classrooms would be necessary by the middle "fifties."

The occasion for the talk was also Girl Scout Day observance. Mrs. Godshall pointed out that if there were more groups like the Girl Scouts, the world of growing boys and girls, would be a nicer place in which to live.

The famous words of Daniel Webster, "I was born an American; I shall live an American; I shall die an American," ended Mrs. Godshall's powerful and moving talk. Mrs. LeRoy Swinney, former Girl Scout council president, introduced the speaker.

Girl Scout troop 12, under the leadership of Mrs. Dick Lunsford, presented a musicale preceding the afternoon's speaker. Mrs. Swinney introduced each girl scout. During the business session, Mrs. Annie Fennell, president, honored the Girl Scouts and expressed the club's gratitude on being able to sponsor such a wonderful organization. 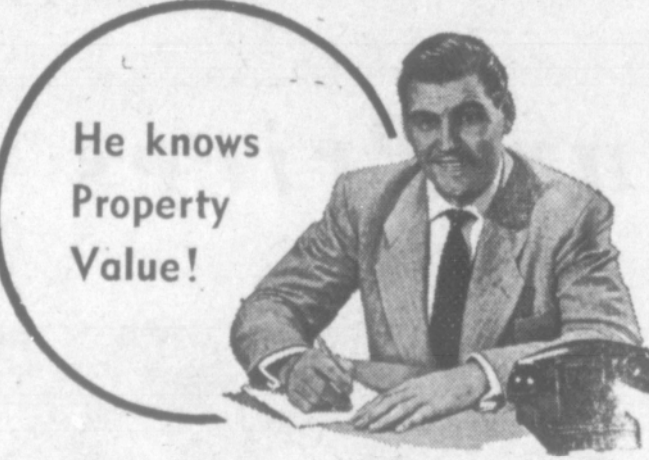

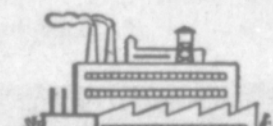

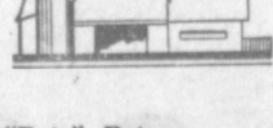
