

Motorists Get School Bus Stop Warnings

Oregon's law requiring motorists to stop for school buses that have stopped to load or unload children will soon call for renewed attention by Oregon drivers, the state traffic safety division reminded today.

Many buses have been transporting farm workers during the summer, an operation to which the stop law does not apply.

The law, adopted by the 1949 state legislature, exempts from stopping only vehicles approaching the bus from the opposite direction on the far side of a roadway having three or more lanes.
