If you didn't see the sign or if you just ignored it, try this. If the dress is washable rub vaseline into the paint stain. Then soak the garment in turpentine until the paint softens and wash the garment in warm soap and water. If the dress isn't washable, try rubbing the spot gently with a pad of tawling or cheesecloth soaked in turpentine. If this doesn't work, take the garment to your dry cleaner but be sure to tell him where the spot is and what it is.

There's a special knack required in cleaning and pressing the heavier fabrics in overcoats and topcoats. We think we do an unusually fine job on these garments and suggest you give us a trial.

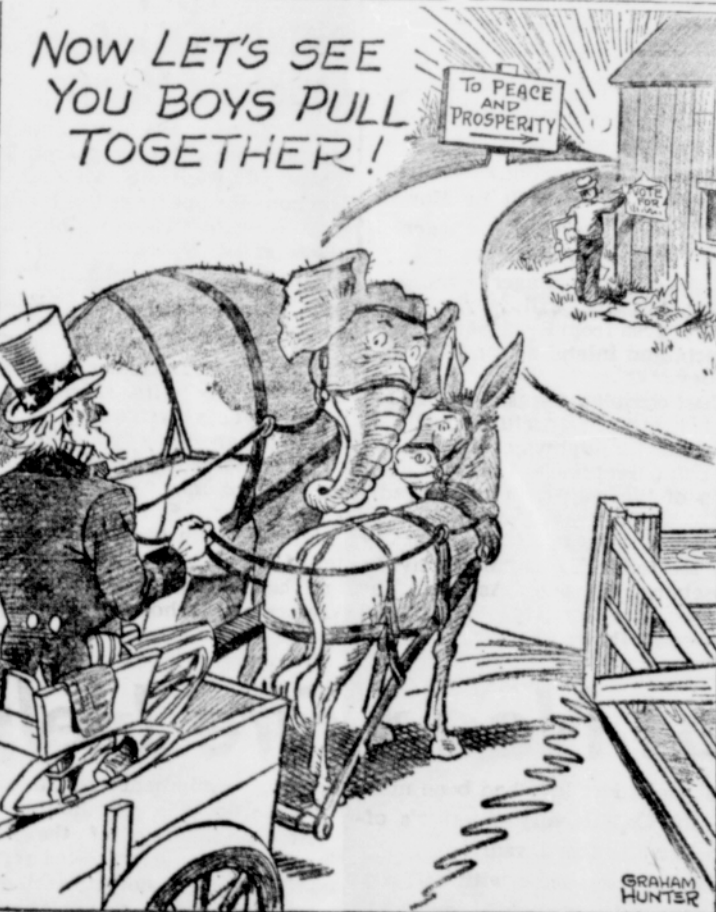
