Coquille's Chamber of Commerce got fast action from Washington, D. C. when they fired wires to the congressional representatives asking support of the Riddle-Norway transmission line, and the restoration of a million dollar cut in funds.

Clarence Osika, chamber manager, had telegrams today. Congressman Harris Ellsworth: He pledged his support of every-

thing asked by the Coquille chamber. He said he will fight for Item 132 in the Interior appropriation bill.

Senator Wayne Morse: Full support of the Normay-Riddle line and he is aware of its great need. In the meantime the fight was continuing with the Coquille chamber taking the cudgel up to get action on the important bill. It means more power for this area and it means the alleviating of a danger signal for the area from power shortages seen in 1956 unless the line comes through.
