Casserole Dish Recipes Chosen By Home Unit

These recipes for casserole dishes were chosen by members of the Coquille Home Extension Unit as their favorites. Chances are good, too, that they'll rate as "tops" with the families of homemakers who give them a try. And, good news for wives, they take but a minimum of time to prepare.

TUNAFISH AND NOODLE CASSEROLE

3 cups raw noodles (6 ounces) or 4 1/2 cups cooked
1 cup Tuna, flaked
1 can (1 1/4 cups) condensed mushroom soup
1 teaspoon salt
1 tablespoon butter
2 teaspoons pimento, cut fine (if desired)

Cook and drain noodles. Add other ingredients in order given and place in greased casserole. Bake in moderate oven (350 degrees) for 30 minutes.

BAKED CHEESE

1/2 cup mashed potatoes
1/2 cup cottage cheese
1 tablespoon butter
Chopped green pepper

Season to taste, using plenty of black pepper. Mix and place in greased baking dish. Bake in mod-shaker-type bottles, so that they're quick and simple to use.

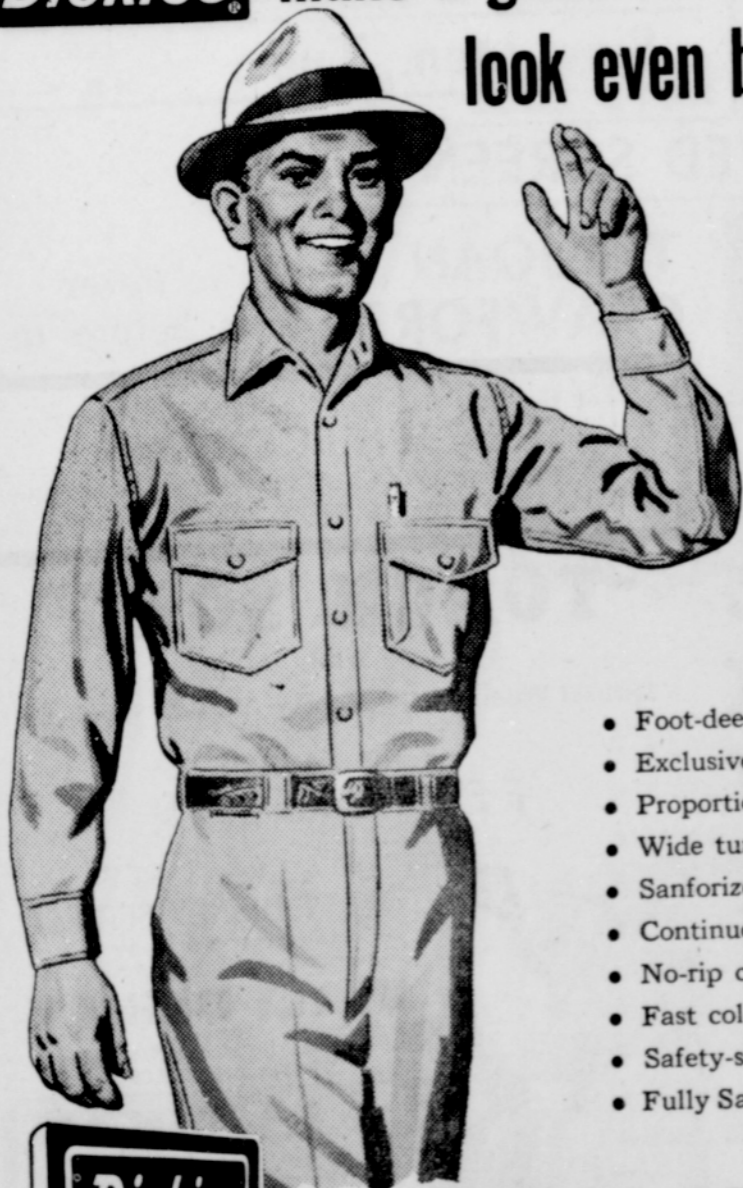

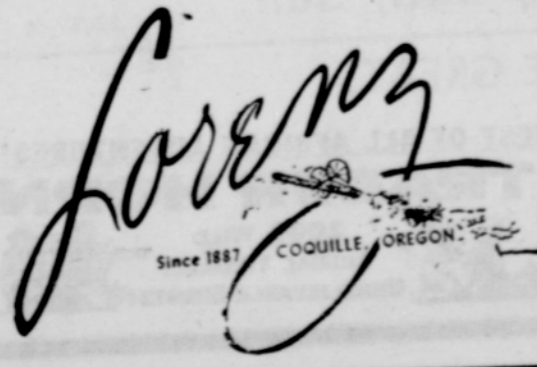
