NOTICE OF PROPOSED ASSESSMENT

Notice is hereby given that on the 18th day of October, 1954, there was filed in the office of the City Recorder and the Committee on Streets of the Common Council of the City of Coquille, a proposed assessment for the construction of a sewer and connections, commencing at the existing sewer commonly known as Sewer "C" at a point approximately 3,067 feet Northerly from man-hole D near the sewage disposal plant of the City of Coquille and extending Westerly on various parcels and streets in which is commonly known as Sanford Heights area, approximately to the West City boundary in the City of Coquille, Coos County, Oregon, being known as Sewer "D."

The whole cost of said improvement to the property owners and the said proposed assessment is the sum of \$26,065.67, and the boundaries of the district proposed to be assessed are as follows:

Notice hereby is given that the Coos-Curry Electric Cooperative, Inc. an Oregon corporation, whose address is Coquille, Oregon, has filed with the Hydroelectric Commission of Oregon an application for a preliminary permit to appropriate waters of the State of Oregon in a stream known as Illinois River, a tributary of Rogue River, for the development of a Hydroelectric Power Project designated on the records of the Commission as Project No. 190. The applicant proposes to develop a maximum of 368,182 theoretical horsepower, utilizing a maximum of 7,500 cubic feet per second of water from Illinois River under a maximum head of 432 feet. A concrete overflow diversion dam of a maximum height of 100 feet would be located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 36, Township 36 South, Range 11 West, Willamette Meridian and a power house would be located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 21, Township 36 South, Range 11 West, Willamette Meridian in Josephine County, Oregon. The conduit would be a 3.9 mile pressure tunnel 19 feet in diameter. The project would be a run-of-river type.

NOW THEREFORE, notice hereby is given to all persons that the Hydroelectric Commission of Oregon will hold a public hearing on said application beginning on the 22nd day of November, 1954, at the hour of 10:00 a. m. at the County Court House of Coos County in the city of Coquille, Oregon, to consider all protests or remonstrances on behalf of the public or of any corporations or districts organized for public purposes or of any interested private person or persons.

All protesting or remonstrances to the granting of such preliminary permit must be filed with the Secretary of the Hydroelectric Commission at Salem, Oregon, on or before November 18, 1954, and must be in writing and verified by the parties protesting and a certified copy thereof must be served upon the applicant for the permit on or before November 18, 1954.

ORDER

IN THE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR THE COUNTY OF COOS

IN THE MATTER OF THE proposed incorporation of the Rink Creek Water District

Now this matter coming on before the County Court sitting for the transaction of County business, at a regular meeting, for consideration of the petition of certain voters within the boundaries of the real property hereinafter described, situate in Coos County, Oregon, that there be submitted to the legal voters the question whether said area shall be incorporated as a domestic water supply corporation;

It appearing from affidavits of publication and posting on file herein that the County Clerk of Coos County, Oregon, gave notice of hearing to be held on October 1, 1954 at 3 o'clock p.m. at the County Courtroom, Courthouse, Coquille, Oregon, by causing such notice to be posted at three public and conspicuous places in the area to be incorporated continuously from September 10th, 1954 until October 1st, 1954, and to be published once a week for two successive weeks; that is, on September 16th, 1954, September 23rd, 1954, and September 30th, 1954, in the Coquille Sentinel, a newspaper published at Coquille, Coos County, Oregon, and having general circulation in the area proposed to be incorporated, which notice stated in substance that a

petition had been filed for establishment of a domestic water supply corporation, the name and boundaries of the proposed corporation, the time and place that the petition would be presented to the County Court for hearing, and that all persons interested may appear and be heard;

Said petition having been presented to this court at the time and place set forth in the aforesaid notice, this court did hear all the persons interested and considered all evidence and arguments;

It appearing from the records of the County Clerk that there are approximately 15 legal voters within the area proposed to be incorporated, and that ten legal voters, constituting more than 25% of the legal voters within the area proposed to be incorporated, have signed the petition presented.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS CONSIDERED, ORDERED, AND ADJUDGED:

1. That the petition of certain legal voters living within the following described real property, Coos County, Oregon, petitioning that there be submitted to the legal voters of said area the question whether or not said area shall be incorporated as a municipal corporation to be known as Rink Creek Water District is determined to be in proper form, contains adequate signatures, and is hereby approved.

2. That the description of the exterior boundaries of the proposed corporation, including all territory which may be benefited by inclusion within the corporation and not including any land which will not, in the judgment of the court be benefited, is as follows, to-wit:

In N 1/2 of Section 7, Township 28 South, Range 12 Coos County, Oregon, Begin at the quarter section corner of the North boundary of Section Seven (7), Township Twenty-eight (28) South, Range Twelve (12) West of the Willamette Meridian; run thence Easterly along the North boundary of Section Seven (7) to the North and South 1/16 Section line through the Northeast quarter (NE 1/4) of said Section Seven (7); thence South along said 1/16 line to the Southwest corner of said Northeast quarter (NE 1/4); thence continuing (NE 1/4) of Northeast quarter (NE 1/4) of Section Seven (7) 0' 40' East along said 1/16 section line a distance of 167.1 feet to a point; thence South 67' 41' East a distance of 143.3 feet; thence North 83' 54' East 219.1 feet; thence South 10' 49' East 581.4 feet to the right bank of Rink Creek; thence along said right bank on the following courses; thence South 46' 35' West 69.8 feet; thence South 65' 33' West 422.5 feet; thence leaving said right bank and running North 07' 43' West 742.3 feet; thence South 76' 14' West 282.7 feet, more or less, to the Southeast boundary of the Rink Creek county road; thence run Southwesterly along said Southeast boundary to a point on the West boundary of property conveyed to Elmer E. Benham and Ida D. Benham, husband and wife in book 192, Page 598, Deed Records, Coos County, Oregon, (said point being approximately 195 feet West of the North and South center line of Section Seven (7); thence run North along the West boundary of property conveyed in said deed to the North boundary of the Southeast quarter (SE 1/4) of the Northwest quarter (NW 1/4) of Section Seven (7); thence East along said North boundary to the North and South centerline of said Section Seven (7); thence North along the North and South centerline of said Section Seven (7) to the point of beginning. All being located in the North half (N 1/2) of Section Seven (7), Township Twenty-eight (28) South, Range Twelve (12).

3. That an election shall be held within the proposed corporation area between the hours of 8 o'clock a.m. and 8 o'clock p.m. on November 12, 1954, to submit to the legal voters within the boundaries of said proposed corporation who have resided there for a period of not less than ninety days next preceding the election, the question whether the above described area shall be incorporated as a domestic water supply corporation.

4. The polling place for said election shall be the Jack Calhoun premises on Rink Creek

Road, within the boundaries of said area, Coquille, Oregon.

5. The County Clerk shall cause to be printed ballots in the form required by law, and shall take all steps necessary to provide election supplies and to conduct said election as required by Chapter 264, Oregon Revised Statutes.

6. Copies of this order shall be posted for four successive weeks in three public places within the proposed corporation and shall also be published once a week for four successive weeks prior to the election in the Coquille Valley Sentinel, a newspaper published at Coquille, Coos County, Oregon, and having general circulation in the area proposed to be incorporated.
