Coast artillery. Served in Africa, Italy, France and Belgium. Remembers staying alive sort of helped me to get through it.

U.S. ARMY
1 Apr. 1941 - Nov. 1945
General Patton's 3rd Army. Automatic weapons Bn. 71st Infantry. Served in the European Theatre. Strongest memory was when I saw the amount of aircraft coming out of England and the burnt out tanks and general carnage.

Infantryman. Served in Italy. Was in charge of mules in Italy.

Navigator, 15th Air Force. Was a prisoner of war. Served in Europe. Lost our lead plane in one mission so I became the lead navigator.

30 July 1941 - 30 July 1947
Naval airplane mechanic. Served in the South Pacific.

Office work. Served stateside. Training in Palm Beach, Fla. Stationed in Boston, Massachusetts. Served stateside. Training was in Palm Beach, Fla. Stationed in Boston, Massachusetts. Radio operator, search outfits, Coast Artillery. Stateside duty. Served in the South Pacific as well. Three days out when the war ended. We were an Army of Occupation at the time. In order to get to Japan from the Philippines we had to "hitch" a ride on an LST. Quite a trip.

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CALEB BELL
U.S. NAVY
1943 to 1946
Radio Man - served in the South Pacific.

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JAMES H. GIBBS
U.S. NAVY
26 Nov. 1941 - 25 Oct. 1945
Electrician. Served in the South Pacific. Recalls getting bombed by Kamikaze planes. Nineteen of them tried to hit our carrier.

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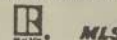


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
