Military Police. Served Stateside.

NOV. 1942 - NOV. 1944
Ordinance outfit. Worked on small boats mounting guns - San Francisco. Trained troops at Camp Adair. Served Stateside. Made a lot of friends. Often wondered what happened to them. Capt. McKay was our head man and later became Governor of Oregon.

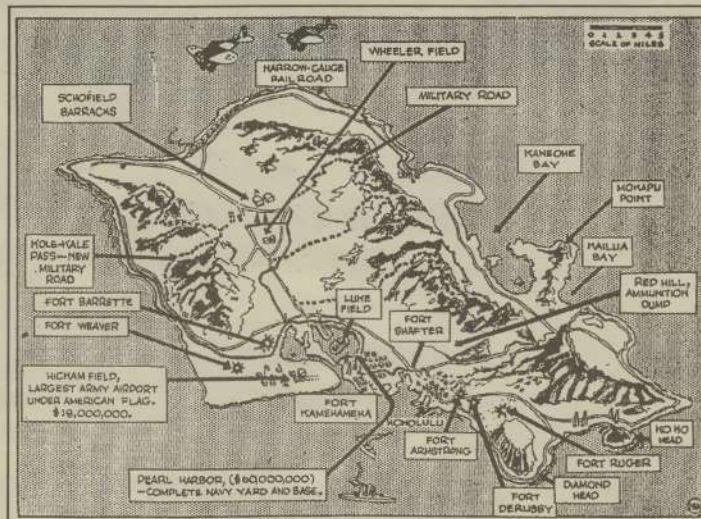
