**KENNETH PAUL
ANDERSON**
U.S. ARMY
1943 - Dec. 1944

Infantryman. Served in the European Theatre. Was in the Battle of the Bulge in Germany. Killed in action.

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MARVIN L. BARKLEY
U.S. ARMY

31 Aug. 1943 - 3 Mar. 1945
Tank Driver. Served in Germany. Received the Bronze Star and the Purple Heart. Killed in action on the banks of the Rhine River.

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EDWARD O. BROOKS
Killed in action.

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HARRY M. BROWN
U.S. MARINES
1942 - 17 Mar. 1945

Rifleman. Served in Iwo Jima. Killed in action.

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**FRANCES STOKES
CAFFEY**
U.S. MARINE CORPS
13 Dec. 1941 - 15 June 1944

Served in the Asiatic Pacific area from 3 Nov. 1942 to 15 June 1944. Participated in action against the enemy at Guadalcanal, Solomon Islands 4 Jan. 1943 to 8 Feb. 1943. Tarawa Gilbert Islands 21 Nov. 1945 to 23, Saipan Marianas Island to 15 June 1944. Killed in action. Received the Purple Heart, Presidential Unit Citation Ribbon Bar with Star, Asiatic Pacific Campaign Medal. WWII Victory Medal.

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**HERBERT STANLEY
EVANS**
U.S. ARMY AIR FORCE
98th Bomb Squadron. Served in the South Pacific. Killed in action. Plane went down somewhere over the Marianas Islands.

HELD**

Killed in action.

Infantry. Served in Italy. Received the Purple Heart. Killed in action.

U.S. NAVY
1944 - 1946

Radarman. Served in Leyte, and the South Pacific. Night action - Japanese Submarine fired on them. Ship sunk in 3 minutes. It took a direct hit amidship. Killed in action.

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STANLEY R. FELSHER
1940

Served in the South Pacific. Died on the Bataan March.

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**RALPH RICHARD
POINTER**
U.S. ARMY
1942

Medics. Served in German, European Theatre. Killed in action.



**DALLAS LEE
WORKMAN**
U.S. ARMY
1944 - 1945

Paratrooper. Served in the South Pacific. and the Philippines. Killed in action.

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**GUSSIE LEROY
JEWETT**
U.S. ARMY

Mar. 1942 - May 1944
Ranger. Served in Anzio, Italy. Killed in action.

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**PHILLIP FRANCIS
BARTLETT**
U.S. ARMY AIR FORCE
Pilot. Served in the South Pacific. On patrol maneuvers plane crashed into a mountain. Killed in action. He was buried in Hawaii.

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WALLACE J. CARL
Killed in action.

ARMOS MANNILA
U.S. MARINE CORPS
Nov. 1941

Served in the South Pacific. Killed in action on Saipan June 15, 1944.

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ELMER A. ROWAN
Killed in action.

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HAROLD ALVIN REED
1943 - 1944

Drove amphibious craft "Duck". Served in the South Pacific and Saipan. Killed in action.

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HARRY D. RANKIN
Killed in action.

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**FRENDY D.

U.S. ARMY
1940

Served in the South Pacific. Killed in action on the Bataan Death March.
