The 7 million dollar Beaver Hill Disposal Site upgrade, is two-thirds completed, on time and budget. A third, 2 million dollar, 50 ton per day incinerator and 3 million dollar air quality scrubber system has been installed and is being source tested for compliance with Federal EPA and Oregon DEQ guidelines. Ten thousand cubic yards of drain rock is currently being stockpiled on site to begin construction of ash trench #3.

Coos County is also working on more and better ways to recycle glass, metal and plastic to work toward the 50% reduction of solid waste required by the year 2000. The state goal for Coos County is 15%. However, we have achieved 21% for the past 3 years.
