KARLAS SEIDEL, COUNTY SURVEYOR EXT. - 351

The Surveyor's office is constantly working on public land survey corner restoration. We have a project in the Catching Creek, Ward Creek area that includes government section corners and 1/4 corners in approximately a 6 square mile area. During this project we have rented Menasha's GPS (Global Positioning System) satellite receivers which has sped up the work immensely.

This office is a cooperator in an agreement with nine other agencies to increase the density of GPS monumentation in Coos County. The nine agencies are: Menasha, Georgia Pacific Corporation, Moore Mill, International Paper, Weyerhaeuser, Coos Bay-North Bend Water Board, Lone Rock Timber and Coos-Curry Electric Co-op. This work will double the number of ground satellite stations and in the long term will benefit all of Coos County.

The surveyor's office along with the Assessor's office, Planning Dept., Data Processing and Sheriff's office has been involved with the development of a county GIS (Geographic Info. System). This project may take a number of years to initialize, but there will be many benefits to the citizens of Coos County.

We also do field and office checks on all subdivision plats and partition plats. In 1995 there were 48 partitions and 9 subdivisions. Also survey work necessary for other departments especially the road, parks, solid waste and forestry.

The County Surveyor also checks and corrects all descriptions for the County Land Sales.

The office helps the private surveyors and the public with research for surveys or corners on properties.

Coos County is currently in Periodic Review which is a process required by state law. To complete this process we have gone through a series of public meetings to identify the work tasks.
