To Lena Clementine Jones and Gus Jones, her husband; Millie May Smith and Carl Smith, her husband: In the Name of the State of Oregon: You are hereby summoned and required to appear and answer the Complaint of the above named Plaintiff filed against you in the above entitled Court and cause, in the office of the County Clerk of Coos County, Oregon, within six weeks from the date of the first publication of this Summons, namely, within six weeks from the 18th day of April, 1920, the same being May 28th, 1920, and the same being the last day of the time prescribed in the Order of Publication of Summons herein, for the Defendants to answer the Plaintiff's Complaint, and if you fail so to appear and answer said Complaint, for want thereof the Plaintiff will apply to the Court for the relief demanded in his said Complaint, of which the following is a succinct statement, viz: That you, said Defendants, be ordered to produce all claims which any of you have or make upon the whole or any part of the real property involved in this suit; that this Court determine said claims to be invalid and of no effect and perpetually restrain you from asserting them thereafter; that all such claims be quieted and that Plaintiff, John Robinson, be declared to be the owner in fee and of right in the possession of all of the real property described in the Complaint on file herein, namely: Beginning at a post marked C.
