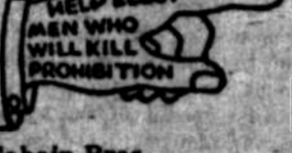

(Verbatim copy of letter presented to Senatorial Investigating Committee, at Chicago, by Chairman Will H. Hays of Republican National Committee.)

Dear Sir and Brother: The organized liquor trade of New Jersey has set out to do its part toward the election of James M. Cox as the next President of the United States...



The nomination of Governor Cox of Ohio for the presidency by the Democrats is a big victory for our interests and it can be attributed to a great degree to the activity of our trade organizations here in New Jersey and throughout the nation.
