Conveying Stotten Iron to Molds. A new device for handling molter ires in a gray iron foundry has been invented by a Cleveland toundryman It is in use in his own foundry and to a labor-saving machine as well as a very efficient one. The device consists essentially of a cylindrical ladie mounted on trunnions in such a way that the iron may be discharged through nozzies which become sub-merged when the ladle is rofated. The metal flows from the nozzles into two semi-circular guide troughs which convey it to the runners leading to the mold. The entire apparatus is carried on a frame mounted on wheels which render it readily portable.—Scientific
