Another China Town Wiped Out Salinas, Cal, May 17—Chinatown, on the shore line between Pacific Grove and Monterey, was totally destroyed by fire last night. Of four hundred shacks on seven remain. Four hundred refugees from San Francisco Chinatown lost everything. The loss is \$45,000.
