To Mobilize Troops.

Washington, Jan. 30.—Inquiry

into the war department reveals a

report from Omaha for a mobiliza-

tion of a large part of the army on

the Pacific coast about the time of

the arrival of Evan's fleet. It

also develops the fact of a move-

ment now in contemplation to dis-

patch troops to the Philippines to

relieve the soldiers who are ready

for their discharge. Assistant Sec-

retary Oliver is in correspondence

with the governors of many states

and territories with a view to coor-

perate of the militia with the regular

army in an active program of joint

drills and maneuvers on the Pacific

coast. Several governors are already

in correspondence with the railroad

transportation agencies relative to

the movements of their militia forces

to the sites of the proposed

camps. It is believed this is founda-

tion for the assumption that large

troop movements toward the

Pacific coast are projected.
