For this reason allow me to send to you for publication some remarks which should be read by all fruit grow. urday. ers and advice taken.

The pruning season for Coos county begins as soon as the leaves in the fall have dropped off the tree, go Monday. and lasting until the latter part of February, during which time when Drug Store. frost is on the trees, pruning must be delayed until the frost is thawed ceiued at Robinson's. out. Spraying for our insects here should begin as soon as leaves fall in autumn. The most profitable spray is Bordeau's Mixture, the composition of which is sulphate of copper, six pounds; lime, four pounds; water fifty gallons.

To prepare this I will give further instructions in your next issue.

The second spraying should be done as soon as the buds begin to swell, the third spraying when the blossoms fall; the two latter sprays must be of a modified strength. M. G. POHL.
