Wichita, Kan., May 27.—Peter Ruddy, his wife and two children were killed in a tornado that passed seven miles east of Alva, Okla., near midnight last night. Several persons were injured. A number of farm houses were destroyed or damaged and growing crops suffered much loss. Three persons were killed and one child is missing at Ingersoll, Okla., as the result of a tornado striking that town last night. Considerable damage was done to property.
