State Building Railroad

San Antonio, Tex., Sept. 17.—A practical experiment in railroad construction and operation has been undertaken by the state of Texas. The state is building a line of railway from Palestine to the penitentiary at Rusk. About 15 miles of the track has been completed, and work on the remaining 14 miles is being rapidly pushed. The state officials say they expect to learn by actual construction and operation the immediate cost of railway building and running, and that public information so obtained with juggling bookkeeping will be a basis of argument for future railroad rates. The fact that the state operates iron works at Rusk gives a financial reason for this government ownership of a railroad.
