Death of John Hamblock.

Tuesday May 11th occurred the death of Mr. John Hamblock one of the pioneers of Coos county and who settled near Bandon in 1857 and has been identified with many interests in the development of this entire section. He was an honest, upright citizen, and made friends wherever he went.
His wife's maiden name was Jane Ann Long, born in Canada in 1849. Mr. Hamblock was born in Germany July 9, 1827, and was 81 years, 10 months and 2 days of age at the time of his death.

Mr. Hamblock, having been a resident of Coos county for over fifty years is probably as well known and as highly esteemed as any man in the county. He was an upright, honorable gentleman and his friends are limited only by his acquaintances.

The funeral services were held at the residence near Bullards this afternoon at 2:00 and interment was made in the Bullards cemetery.—Recorder.
