A Lard-Tax City

Within a few years the city of Vancouver, B. C., has grown from a few thousand people to one of about 80,000 population, and in the past ten years its property valuation has grown from less than \$20,000,000 to over \$75,000,000. In this progressive city, though it is within British territory, the single tax idea is largely carried out. Since 1906 improvements on real estate, including all buildings, have paid only 4 mills on the dollar tax, while land values have paid 16 mills, just four times as much. And hereafter land will pay all, and improvements on land nothing. This year nearly \$25,000,000 worth of property, namely, improvements on land—factories, mills, residences, etc.—was assessed nothing at all. The property tax is all placed on land. Under this policy the city has grown rapidly and prospered exceedingly. It encourages improvement and offers no premium on speculation in idle land. Doubtless Vancouver had people who predicted that this policy would be ruinous, but like most pessimists these croakers were mistaken. With taxes centered on land values, development healthy booms.—Portland Daily Journal.

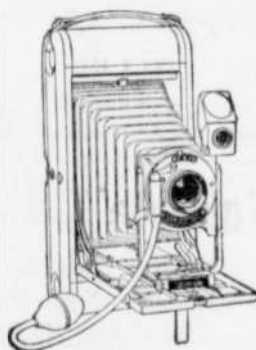
