A Few Election Notes.

Owing to the great length of the tickets, counting is necessary now. It will be evening before the Marshfield precincts are counted, but from all reports, so far as we have been able to gather information from those bringing in returns from the precincts where the count has been made it would indicate that Coos county will elect, for Circuit Judge, John S. Coke, County Judge, John F. Hall; Sheriff, W. W. Gage, Clerk, Jas. Watson; Treasurer, T. M. Dimmick; Surveyor, A. N. Gould.

Death of Rachael Wilson.

Rachael Wilson was born January 10th 1854 in Allen County Ohio. Her mother died when she was three weeks old and her father when she had come to the age of two years. About the time of her father's death she contracted typhoid fever which checked the development of her mind so that she was never more than a child in intellect. Of she is the Kingdom of Heaven. She died Nov. 6th 1910 and was buried the next day from the home of her brother-in-law, Mr. David Fulton. Many floral offerings were brought to the funeral. At its close they were very thoughtfully sent to brighten the rooms of the sick throughout our city.

When Rachel Wilson's mother knew that she was about to die she entrusted the baby to the care of her sister, now Mrs. David Fulton of Coquille. The faithfulness with which that trust has been executed is one of the glories of the Christian life and will entitle our beloved neighbor to a place very near the throne. Inasmuch as ye did it unto one of these my brethren, even these least, ye did it unto me.

From Albany College

On the 26th of October the students of Albany College from Coos and Curry Counties met at the residence of Miss Winnifred Root for the purpose of organizing a club. There were ten persons present, eight from Coos County, and two from Curry.

The name adopted by the club is the "Coos and Curry County Club." The club was formed for the purpose of having social good times together, and for instruction along literary lines.

The names of the persons who formed the club are as follows: A. R. Hodge, H. K. Hodge, and Myrtle Hodge, all of Arago; A. R. Jones, L. A. Jones, of Myrtle Point; T. S. Easton, of Sitkum; L. Osborn, of Bandon; Winnifred Root, of North Bend; Ethel Cheever, Langlois, Magnolia White, Port Orford.

The following officers were elected: President, A. Hodge; vice pres., A. Jones; secretary, Winnifred Root; treasurer, L. Osborn. Two committees were appointed: T. Easton, Ethel Cheever, and L. Jones were on a committee for forming a constitution; Magnolia White, L. Osborn, and Myrtle Hodge were placed on an entertainment committee.

It was decided to have the club meet during the first week of each month, special meetings to be held during holidays.

When all business had been finished the meeting was adjourned and the remainder of the evening spent in a social way.

On Wednesday, the second of November, the first regular meeting of the club was held, at the residence of Miss Ethel Cheever. At this meeting the constitution, which had been drawn up by the committee appointed for the purpose, was adopted. After playing a few games the party collected in an adjoining room when a bountiful repast was served.

The different members, after discussing the parts of the state in which they have been, decided unanimously that the country surrounding Coos Bay is the best in the state. As they wended their ways homeward they were more than convinced that the newly organized club will be both a literary and social success.
