John T. Long, democratic candidate for prosecuting attorney for the third district comprising the counties of Coos, Curry and Douglas, called at the Herald yesterday. Mr. Long handed us a card with his profile printed in brown, but whether this has any significance regarding his opponent we are not advised. In order to form the acquaintanceship of as many people as possible, Mr. Long will visit the fair at Myrtle Point at the conclusion of which other towns of the county will be paid a call. He is a pleasant gentleman and it is our opinion the democrats made no mistake in naming him for the important position. Mr. Long is making a thorough canvass of Coos county for his election to the office of prosecuting attorney, notwithstanding that some may be of the opinion that he would not file his acceptance of nomination. He informs us that his acceptance is now on file in the office of the secretary of state and the county clerks of Douglas, Coos and Curry counties, and being the nominee regularly named by the democratic party will most certainly use his utmost endeavors to be elected prosecuting attorney for this district.

Congressman Hawley Pays Coquille a Visit

Willis C. Hawley, representative in congress, arrived in Marshfield Saturday last on his annual visit to Coos county. He remained in the Bay City until Tuesday morning when he took the train for Myrtle Point, leaving that place for Coquille in the afternoon. In the evening an informal reception was tendered Mr. Hawley at the Ko Keel Klub rooms where matters relative to the general welfare of the people were mentioned by him.

When asked for information regarding the jurisdiction of the Myrtle Point port commission, Mr. Hawley stated he was of the opinion that it did not extend outside the limits of the port. At least it appeared to him it should not. Judge Sperry being appealed to said he had investigated the subject and had reached the conclusion that under the statute authorizing the creation of ports, where such a port was created on the upper portion of a river and not extending to the sea, it was incumbent upon such port to care for the stream between its boundary and the sea. That the establishment of such port would prevent any other port being established between it and the sea, for the reason that the statute gives the upper port full control of the stream from its boundary to its mouth and provides no method for doing away with that control, unless the upper port will, at an election, vote to annex the territory below it and the voters of the territory proposed to be annexed also vote for it.

Old soldiers present were informed that district pension bureaus had been discontinued and hereafter payment of pensions would be made direct from Washington.

Timber land, homestead laws and other topics were spoken of.

Mr. Hawley said people on the outside viewed Coos county's resources as consisting principally of timber and coal, whereas he believed the greatest revenue in future years would be derived from dairying, with fruit a close second. He would attend the fair at Myrtle Point to personally investigate the products of this section that he might speak with knowledge in answer to questions regarding our agricultural possibilities.

Congressman Hawley was of the opinion that railroads to the interior would be in operation in two years, and an influx of settlers, greater in magnitude than had ever settled in a like area in Oregon would utilize the land long dormant to the profit of themselves and the well being of mankind.

Wednesday morning Mr. Hawley took the boat for Bandon.

GOV. WEST WILL DO SO SOON

Only Held in Custody Pending Action on Petition for Full Pardon—Good News for Foote's Many Friends

Foote has never been officially incarcerated but has been in custody pending the action by the governor on his application for pardon.

"I would pardon him," was the laconic reply of one newspaper reporter.

"Well," said the Governor, as he smilingly leaned back in his chair, "I am not prepared to say just what I will do, but if I predict that it will not be long before he will be free you will not miss it."

As Vile As Murder

The Portland Journal says that in order to protect his wife and sixteen children from the shame of a second trial, W. R. Foote, an aged rancher of Coquille, indicted for first degree murder, has pleaded guilty of manslaughter and will go to the penitentiary.

Foote shot and killed Chas. Wilcox on the streets of Coquille. In explanation he charged that his seventeen-year old daughter had been ruined, and that the ruin of his thirteen-year-old daughter had been attempted by Wilcox. At the first trial the jury disagreed.

When the old man shot Wilcox he took the law into his own hands. He pursued a course that no man has a right to pursue. He committed the error that men who have wrongs, real or fancied, often commit. His present pathetic situation is the result of that blunder, and is, of course of his own making.

Yet, society owes a duty to such men as old man Foote. Society is not doing its duty by such men as old man Foote. Society is not properly dealing out justice to scoundrels who wrong the daughters of such men as old man Foote.

There is no blacker crime on the calendar than that charged by the Coquille rancher against the man he shot. There is no fouler infamy than the act of a man who takes advantage of the weakness of a girl of seventeen. There is no more atrocious outrage than the act of a man who attempts the ruin of a child of thirteen, a crime Foote charged against Wilcox, and a crime with which a man is now charged in the city of Portland.

If society is going to punish old man Foote, and it should, it should also give to men of the class who provoked his act, a punishment to fit their crimes. It should cease to treat lightly the debauching of youth. It should revise its code of morals and convince fathers that the law will protect their daughters.

It should class and punish seduction and rape as murder, for they are crimes as cruel as murder and as vile as murder.
