An Ants' Sewing Circle.

A party of German naturalists recently returned from Ceylon have reorted the existence of a species of ant ewing two leaves together for the purpose of forming a nest. This report confirms the observations of the English naturalist Ridley, made in 1890. They saw a row of the insects pulling the edges of leaves together, then others trimming and fitting the edges, and still other ants which fastened the edges with a silky thread yielded by line larvae of the same species the workers carried in their mandibles.
