A Pernicious System. After feeling the public pulse the speculators and banking syndicates decide that it will be unwise to urge the issue of another \$100,000,000 of government bonds. So they have resorted to two expedients-first, to loan the government \$20,000,000 of gold; second, to form a pool of \$25,000,000 to prevent the further export of gold by selling exchange "short."
