NO LIVES LOST ON THE WARSHIPS. Twenty Minutes' Shooting Silenced Matanzas's Batteries.

SPANIARDS ARE POOR MARKSMEN—All Their Shots Flew Wild—With the Americans It Was Different—Their Shells Missed and Destroyed.

ADmiral Sampson's fleet last Wednesday turned its guns on the Spanish batteries and forts in the Matanzas harbor and all but destroyed them.

THE American vessels were reconnoitering for the purpose of locating the batteries, when they were fired on.

THE Spanish fleet was commanded by Admiral Montijo, and consisted of the Reina Maria Cristina, Castilla, Yelapa, San Antonio, Don Juan de Austria, and the gunboats El Cano, General Loas, Isie de Cuba and Marques del Duero.

Buen Ventura, of the Santiago line, sailing from Bilbao, Spain, captured on April 22, when on the way to Pensacola, Fla., by the Nashville.

PEdro, of Bilbao, Spain, a freighter, captured off the coast of Florida on April 22 by the cruiser New York.

MATHilde, loaded with a cargo of rum, captured off Havana on April 23 by the torpedo-boat Porter.

CATALINA, a steel steamer of 3291 tons, bound from New Orleans to Barcelona, Spain, with a cargo of 3100 bales of cotton and 6000 bundles of barrel staves.

MIGUEL JOVE, of the Peninsular line, from New Orleans to Barcelona, Spain, captured on April 24 by the gunboat Helena.

SATURINA, of Bilbao, Spain, captured off Ship Island, Miss., on April 24 by the revenue cutter Winona.

CANDIDA, a two-masted schooner with a cargo of wine, captured on April 24 by the gunboat Wilmington.

ANTONIA, a small schooner captured on April 24 off Key West by the torpedo-boat Porter.

PANAMA, a transatlantic steamer and an auxiliary cruiser of the Spanish navy, captured on the way from New York to Havana on April 26 by the lightship tender Mangrove.

AMBROSIO BOLIVA, carrying 370,000 lb. of silver and 300 tons of wine from Costa Rica to Havana, captured on April 27 off the coast near Cardenas by the monitor Terror.

GUIDO, a steamer hailing from Bilbao, Spain, captured on April 27 off the coast of Cuba by the monitor Terror.

ENGRACIA, a sloop, captured on April 29 off the coast of the Newport. Many other vessels of less importance have been captured too.
