Southern Oregon Mining Out Post. M. P. Ward of Portland, who is connected with the High Line Ditch company of Gold Hill, returned yesterday from a trip to southern Oregon. Placer miners, he says, have all gone to work in Douglas, Josephine and Jackson counties over the aggregate last year, on account of the copious rains, which have started all the creeks to running in a way that bores well for a long, prosperous mining season. The big hydraulic mines of the Illinois and Applegate rivers, as well as those of Cow creek, Wolf creek, Fossil creek, Fossil creek and others, are all running night and day, tearing down the gold-laden hillsides and turning the naturally clear waters of Rogue river and the Umpqua into yellow muddy streams, which angers the fishermen further down toward the coast.
