QUARTER OF A CENT.

An Estimate Expert, Preeminent in His Department, Commands a Big Salary.

But all the high salaries do not go to managers, says Ainslee's Magazine, in an article on "The Big Salaries of New York." An expert who is preeminent in his own department sometimes earns a salary that seems fabulous. In industries where profits are calculated in fractions of a cent on each pound of a commodity produced, the value of an expert who is preeminent in his department is estimated. In the case of sugar refining this is particularly true. Dr. J. Ellis Rodley was convicted at Oroville of perjury on the first ballot. The jury was out ten minutes. Dr. Rodley was accused of conspiracy to secure the estate of William Fuller, a wealthy pioneer farmer of Butte county, by means of a forged will.

The extra session of the California Legislature closed Saturday.

The Bellingham Bay & British Columbia railroad has placed \$1,000,000 trust mortgage on its line of railroad from Whatcom to Seamas, Wash., to secure an issuance of bonds of that amount. The Bank of California is the mortgagee.

Near Santa Cruz, Cal., the Big Creek electric plant is bought by F. W. Billing and J. F. Packard of Utah for \$250,000, who intend to construct a duplicate pole line from Santa Cruz to Big Creek and raise the dam ten feet, making it 40 feet high.

The matter of expropriating 300,000 acres of land from the Olympic forest reserve in Clallam county, Wash., and 200,000 acres in Jefferson county, has been favorably passed upon by the commission of the general land office and is now before Secretary Hitchcock for approval. Indications are that this half-million acres will be restored to the public domain. It will include practically all the valley lands suitable for agriculture, and the forest land on the slopes of the mountains. Two long steel bridges have just been ordered by the Southern Pacific company. One is to cross Bear river, near Wheatland, in Yuba county, and is to be 367 feet long, with nine spans of 40 feet each.
