WAR IN THE TRANSVAL.

London, June 8.—Lord Roberts today announced the capture of the imperial regiment by the Boers near Lindley.

"PRETORIA STATION, June 8.—I regret to report that the Thirteenth imperial yeomanry had to surrender to a very superior force of the enemy on May 31, near Lindley.

"During that day and the following we got two 4.7 and two 12-pounder naval guns on the Van Wyke hill and two five-inch guns on the southeastern spur of Inkekele.

"The attack, which was well planned by Hildyards and carried out with immense dash by the troops, for whom no mountains were too steep, outflanked enemy, who were forced to retire from their very strong position.
