Laborers are very scarce throughout California.

The fruit packers of the state met at San Jose five days ago and perfected an organization.

It is expected that there are to be several changes among the faculty of the University of California at Berkeley.

Dr. Robert Locke, a newspaper correspondent recently from Manilla, committed suicide at San Francisco a few days ago.

James L. Rounds of Indianapolis, Ind., committed suicide at Portland, Or., by shooting himself.

Farmers in the vicinity of the mud volcanoes are organizing to drive off numerous deer that have appeared there lately and are destroying crops.

The many hold-ops of Los Angeles have prompted the citizens to take steps towards organizing a vigilante committee.

Small boys allowed a kite to fall under a horse's feet at Pasadena. The horse ran through the business section knocking down J. Scudder and seriously injuring his leg. He ran a little farther and knocked Mrs. L. Crosby out of her rig upon the pavement. Her skull was fractured and there is doubt of her recovery.

The trial of Jim Hansen and other Indians for the murder of Bert Horton and wife of Eugene, Or., is in progress before Judge Brown, at Skagway. Hansen admits killing Horton, but denies killing the woman.

Charles Phillips, a 23-year-old young man of Sacramento, and Miss Jennie Vanderpool of Plymouth, Amador county, were drowned in the Cosumnes river, near Plymouth, last week. They were part of a party of pleasure-seekers who were reading the newspaper when they fell in a hole and being unable to swim sank.

Fire started at Sausalville, Cal., a few days ago and consumed 40 houses in the business center of town. The loss is heavy.

A disastrous accident occurred to the Cloverdale-Charlton stage at Yorkville, which resulted in the killing of I. S. Sullivan, justice of the peace in Ukiah. The horses took fright while the driver was delivering a mail pouch, and while rounding a curve Sullivan was thrown into the air, striking on his head. He was killed instantly. Sullivan was on a visit to his son, Robert, of Yorkville.

Judge Edwin Parker, for a long time prominent in legal circles of San Diego, died at one time superior judge of that county, died at San Bernardino aged 68 years.

Captain P. H. Cooper, United States navy has arrived in Port Orchard, where he goes to take command of the Puget sound naval station. Captain Cooper is a well known naval officer and has served with distinction in the Spanish war.

By an explosion of gas at the Ashland Brewing company's brewery at San Diego, Engineer S. F. Murphy was so badly burned that he may not recover. The force of the explosion blew a hole nine feet high through the 16-inch wall. It was caused by gas generated from oil used in the fireroom.

Suicide is epidemic in Chicago. June has seen a score of men and women destroy themselves, and Friday saw a weary and unfortunate one ended life's struggle.

Congressman John A. Barham and daughter reached Santa Rosa from Berkeley a few days ago. In an interview he declared he was not a candidate for re-election, that he does not want the office and would not accept another term.

A man named Waters has been taken to the hospital at Sacramento suffering with smallpox. He had had the disease for a week and had rained about the city unconscious of the seriousness of his case.

During a drunken row in a restaurant in San Jose, Frank Narvez was shot and almost instantly killed by Thomas Winship, an ex-convict. Winship is under arrest and confesses the crime but will probably plead self-defense.
