Holt, Williams, O'Hen and Young at the State Capitol. Portland Oregonian, Jan. 10.]

John C. Young, county clerk, Frank Williams, county auditor, and W. S. O'Hen, of Clackamas county, are in Portland for the purpose of urging upon incoming members of the legislature the merits of the proposed initiative and referendum amendment to the state constitution.

Section 1, of article 4, of the constitution of the State of Oregon shall be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows: Section 1. The legislative authority of the state shall be vested in a legislative body consisting of representatives; but the people reserve to themselves power to propose laws and amendments to the constitution, and to enact or reject any act passed by the legislature.
