dam of the new power plant which is to
utilize the waters of the Mount Hamil-
ton waterbed. Nearly \$1,000,000 will
be expended in building and equip-
ping the plant. The site selected for the
dam and reservoir is on Santa Isabel
creek, near Mount Hamilton. The
reservoir will be about three miles long
and half a mile wide, and the storage
capacity will be sufficient to supply 6000
horsepower. Eighteen miles distant, in
Calaveras valley, will be erected the
electric plant, and from there the power
will be carried to San Francisco.

Philadelphia Scramble.

To make Philadelphia scramble put
one slice of pork and one pound of
beef in a kettle and cover with water.
The beef need by no means be the
usually selected for scramble. Let it
be a mixture of cornmeal and buckwheat,
using one-third of the buckwheat to
two-thirds of the cornmeal. Add salt
to season. Pour this mixture into a
square tin and let it harden overnight.
In the morning slice and fry as you
would cornmeal mush.
