Thomas E. Ketchum, alias "Black Jack," the notorious outlaw, who had terrorized the people of the southwest for the past 15 years, was hanged at Clayton, N. M., for the last of his many crimes, and his head was severed from the body by the rope as if by a guillotine. The headless trunk pitched forward toward the spectators and blood spurted upon those nearest the scaffold. It is stated that too much of a drop was given for so heavy a man.

Ben Heitman, a young German, committed suicide on his ranch near Pomona, Cal., by blowing off the top of his head with a shotgun. He was well to do, having recently purchased a \$6000 ranch, and in addition he had some money in the bank. He left a note in which he said that he was going to go to die, but that he would not ask forgiveness, because he did not deserve it. He signed the note, "Ben Heitman, Fool of Fools."
