About 800 feet of the ditches of both the Sweepstakes and La Grange Mining companies, near Weaver, Cal., were swept away by the recent storm. The damage will amount to about \$75,000.

Police Judge Magnan of San Francisco imposed the record-breaking sentence of \$300 fine upon Ah Jang, who conducted a lottery place at 607 Dupont street. Ah Jang filed an appeal, but was held in \$1,000 bonds.

By a powder explosion Archie Maitner was instantly killed at Bachelor ranch, 12 miles east of Auburn, Cal. He was engaged in thawing out giant powder sticks by means of boiling water and 30 sticks were exploded. Maitner was blown into fragments by the force of the concussion, and the blacksmith shop in which he was working is a total wreck.

The committee having charge of a public masquerade given at Alturas, Cal., for the benefit of the Alturas fund, permitted several of the maskers to caricature Superior Judge Harrington and the gentlemen connected with the prosecution of James W. Brown in the Lookout lynching case. The impersonation of Judge Harrington was particularly offensive, and the action of the committee in sanctioning the appearance of the masker on the floor in such costume is condemned.
